1 Kakatiya University (KU), 2. Mahatma Gandhi University (MGU), 3. Osmania University (OU), 4. Palamur University (PU), 5. Satavahana University (SU), 6. Telangana University (TU).

2. INSTRUCTIONS CONCERNING ENTRANCE TEST

Important Instructions to TSLAWCET & TSPGLCET-2017 Candidates :

- 1) Candidates who wish to apply for TSLAWCET/TSPGLCET-2017 are requested to fill the particulars carefully in ONLINE APPLICATION. The required information should be collected from the relevant documents.
- 2) Candidates are requested to check the filled in particulars before pressing SUBMIT button DURING online application. If candidate wish to change, he/she can change selecting the EDIT button. After verifying and satisfying, submit the ONLINE APPLICATION.
- 3) After submission of ONLINE APPLICATION, if any corrections are to be incorporated, candidate can login to the website with his details and modify the information. If candidate wants to change the information which is not allowed on the website, candidate has to submit their complaint selecting the "Submit Complaint" in Help Desk provided on the Home Page. Data will be changed only if documentary evidence is satisfactory. HENCE, CANDIDATES ARE REQUESTED TO FILL THE ONLINE APPLICATION FORM CAREFULLY

6) It is advised to visit your allotted Examination Center well before so that you can take examination tension-free.

7) **You WILL NOT BE ALLOWED to take exam if you are even one minute late, we suggest you to reach the exam centre before the exam start time.**

3. ELIGIBILITY FOR APPEARANCE AT THE TSLAW COMMON ENTRANCE TEST-2017 (TSLAWCET-2017/TSPGLCET – 2017)

- a) The candidates should be Indian Nationals and should satisfy local/non-local status requirements laid down in the Andhra Pradesh Educational Institutions (Regulations of Admission) Order, 1974 as amended up to date (as per G.O. Ms. No. 26, dt: 24.03.2004 and its amendments).

- b) The candidates other than Indian Nationals should satisfy the rules of the Universities concerned.
- c) The candidates seeking admission in to:

I. LLB 3 Year Course: The Candidates for 3 year LL.B. should have passed any Graduate Degree (10+2+3 pattern) of a recognized University with 45% of aggregate marks or any other examination (10+2+3 pattern) recognized as equivalent by the Universities concerned. If any candidate secured less than 45% in graduation he should have passed any additional graduation or post graduation with 45%.

A Candidate appeared/appearing for the above qualifying examinations may also apply for TSLAWCET – 2017 (LL.B. 3 YDC) in anticipation of results. In case of such students, their admission shall be subject to the passing the qualifying examination and their securing eligible marks in the said qualifying examinations.

Note:

- i) **There is a relaxation of 5% of marks in the above qualifying examinations for 3 year Law course in favour of the Candidates belonging to SC / S.T. Category**
- ii) **The percentage of 39.5% and above in aggregate in graduation in case of candidates belongs to SC/ST category and 44.5% and above in aggregate in graduation in case of candidates belongs other categories will be considered as 40% and 45% for admission in to LL.B 3 year course.**

II. LL.B 5 year course: The Candidates for 5 year LL.B. should have passed two year Intermediate Examination (10+2 pattern) with 45% of aggregate marks or any other examination recognized as equivalent by the University concerned or the Board of Intermediate Education, T.S.

A Candidate appeared/appearing for the above qualifying examinations may also apply for TSLAWCET – 2017 (LL.B. 5 YDC) in anticipation of results. In case of such students, their admission shall be subject to the passing the qualifying examination and their securing eligible marks in the said qualifying examinations.

Note:

- i) **There is a relaxation of 5% of marks in the above qualifying examinations for 5 year Law course in favour of the Candidates belonging to SC / S.T. Category**

ii) **The percentage of 39.5% or above in aggregate in Intermediate (10+2 Pattern) in case of candidates belongs to SC/ST category and 44.5% or above in aggregate in Intermediate in case of candidates belongs other categories will be considered as 40% and 45% for admission in to LL.B 5 year course.**

iii) **Age for admission:** As per the conditions stipulated by the Bar Council of India in this behalf, vide BCI Lr. No. BCI:D1519(LE:Cir-16) dated 17-09-2016, the maximum age limit for a candidate seeking admission into the 3 year LL.B Course shall be **30 (Thirty) Years** (relaxation by **five years** in case of SCs/STs and other Backward Communities) and for 5 year LL.B. course shall be **20 (Twenty) years** (relaxation by **two years** in case of SCs/STs and other Backward Communities) as on date of issue of notification for entrance examination.

Note: Age limit mentioned above is challenged in Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in W.P.No.1023/2016. Hon'ble Supreme Court imposed stay through an interim order on the above notification of BCI which imposed the age restriction in to Law Courses. Hence, there is no age limit for appearing TSLAWCET – 2017 for seeking admission into 3/5 year courses. However, the admissions into the law courses shall be subject to the outcome of the pending case.

III. LL.M Course: Candidates holding LL.B./B.L. degree on the date of application and candidates who have appeared/appearing for LL.B./B.L. Final year examination are also eligible. However he/she should pass the examination at the time of counselling

The Candidates seeking admission into LL.M. (Private Appearance) of Osmania University, Hyderabad shall have a minimum experience of 3-years as a judicial officer or 3-years standing as an advocate on the date of appearing for TSPGLCET-2017.

Mere appearance in TSLAWCET/TSPGLCET will not give any right of admission. The candidate should satisfy all the eligibility criteria and should satisfy rules governing admission as are applicable.

English and Telugu for TSLAWCET-2017, and English only for TSPGLCET- 2017

5. RESULTS:

TSLAWCET-2017

- a) **Qualifying Marks for TSLAWCET-2017:** The qualifying percentage of marks in the Entrance Test is 35% (i.e. 42 marks out of total 120 marks). However, for candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes or Scheduled Tribes, no minimum qualifying percentage of marks is prescribed.
- b) **Evaluation & Ranking:** Every care will be taken to avoid errors in evaluation, checking, scrutiny, tabulation and ranking. Hence, request for re-totalling or revaluation or personal identification of scripts will not be entertained.

The Candidates will be ranked in the order of merit based on the marks obtained in the TSLAWCET-2017. In case of tie the relative rank will be decided as mentioned below:

- i) By considering the marks secured in Part-C of TSLAWCET and if the tie still persists marks obtained in Part-B in TSLAWCET shall be taken into consideration.
- ii) If the tie still persists they may be bracketed together for the purpose of ranking and seniority in age may be considered at the time of admission.
- c) **Rank obtained in TSLAWCET-2017 is valid for admission into 3 year / 5 year Law Courses, as the case may be, for the academic year 2017-2018 only.**
- d) **The Candidates are advised to download the Rank Card from the web site www.lawcet.tsche.ac.in after one week of the publication of results. In case of the any difficulty in downloading the Rank Card the candidates are advised to contact the Convener's Office.**

TSPGLCET-2017 (for LL.M Courses)

- a) **Qualifying Marks for TSPGLCET-2017:** The qualifying percentage of marks in the Entrance Test is 25% (i.e. 30 marks out of total 120 marks). However, for candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes or Scheduled Tribes, no minimum qualifying percentage of marks is prescribed
- b) **Evaluation & Ranking:** Every care will be taken to avoid errors in evaluation, checking, scrutiny, tabulation and ranking. Hence, request for retotalling or revaluation or personal identification of scripts will not be entertained.
- c) The Candidates will be ranked as per the total marks obtained in the Entrance Test. If there is a tie in total marks, the marks obtained in Part-A of Entrance Test will be considered for awarding the rank. If the tie persists they may be bracketed together for the purpose of ranking and seniority in age may be considered at the time of admission.
- d) Rank obtained in TSPGLCET-2017 is valid for admission into LL.M. Courses, as the case may be, for the academic year 2017-2018 only.
- e) Rank Card will not be sent by post. The candidates are advised to download the Rank Card from the web site www.lawcet.tsche.ac.in

Dt. 12.5.1998, the candidates claiming admission**

into this course under reserved quota meant for SC, ST and BC are required to produce **Integrated Community Certificate** issued by the competent authority.
